## BUCKET

(Plastic 5 gal. Bucket with lid)

- ½ gal. Bleach
- 5 scouring pads
- 18 easy wipes
- 7 pack sponges
- 50 oz. Laundry detergent
- 12 oz. Lysol
- 28 oz. Dishwashing liquid
- 2 pr. non-latex gloves
- 50 clothes pins
- 100 ft. clothes line
- 5 pack dust masks
- 1 pr. Work gloves
- 24 garbage bags(25 gal or larger)
- 14 oz. Insect repellent
- 9 oz. Air freshener



## KITCHEN KIT

(to be put in plastic container)

- 1 dish towel
- 1 dish cloth
- 1 bottle dish detergent
- 1 pair non latex gloves
- 1 dish brush
- 1 package eating utensils
- 2 hotpads
- 1 vinyl tablecloth
- 1 small dish drainer

- 1 bottle hand lotion
- 1 bottle hand soap

(to be put in plastic container)

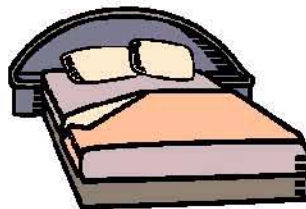
- 1 hand towel

(to be put in plastic container)

- 2 double bed sheets
- 2 pillow cases
- 2 pillows
- 1 double bed blanket

(to be put in plastic container)

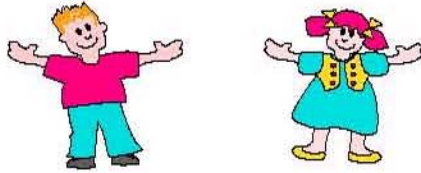
- 1 writing tablet

**Box Type:** Choose a shoe box, and wrap it if you wish, but be sure to wrap the lid separately.

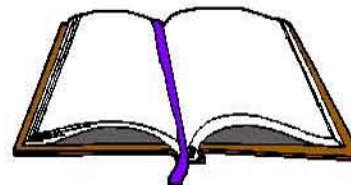
**Filling the Box:** A) Decide if your gift box will be for a girl or a boy; B) Decide the age category, small child ages 2-4, child ages 5-9, youth ages 10-14; C) Gift ideas: baby items, hygiene items, school supplies, non war-related toys, extra items such as T-shirts, socks, sealed hard candies and gum; D) Bible, study Bible, children's picture books or other Bible related booklet, E) Attach an appropriate label on the box lid. An example is found on the next page.
